Our Statement of Purpose: To be committed to Jesus Christ as Lord and to witness to His teachings through worship, education, sharing, caring, and serving the people inside and outside the Church to help them find a mature and abundant life.

WELCOME to our service of worship on this wonderful Lord's Day as we partake of Holy Communion to commemorate the life of John Hus, the father of the Moravian Church. On July 6, 1415, Hus, a catholic priest from Bohemia, was burned at the stake as a heretic. He had defied the church hierarchy by preaching in the common language of the people (rather than Latin), proclaiming the Holy Scriptures to be a higher authority than the Pope, and giving both the bread and the cup to lay people at communion (only priests were to receive the cup). Following Hus' execution, his followers broke away from the Roman Catholic Church and formed what later became the Unitas Fratrum (Unity of the Brethren), today's Moravian Church.
