PRELUDE *Christian Hearts in Love United.....arr. Wade Peeples*
The arrangement of this most familiar hymn is by Wade Peeples, a Moravian composer of our times. This piece is from a larger work commissioned in honor of the founding of the original Moravian settlements in the Salem area.

Wade is married to the eminent organist Mary Lou Kapp Peeples - a graduate of Salem College (where she was a student of John and Margaret Mueller) and of the Eastman School of Music. Several years ago he was commissioned by our church to compose an organ work based on Seelenbrautigam in memory of longtime choir member and friend Todd Arrowood. The work was premiered at Rural Hall Moravian Church during a service commemorating All Saints Day.

The original language of this anthem is German and is based on a text from Lamentations 5:21 Dr. Karl Kroeger, the late director of the Moravian Music Foundation translated and arranged this piece.

John Gambold was an English Moravian, son of a Moravian bishop. He was educated both in England and in Germany.

Records indicate that he served as a missionary to Egypt, where he was captured and tortured - a circumstance undoubtedly contributing to his early death. His music is compared melodically and harmonically to that of Mozart's and Schubert's in Kroeger's estimation.

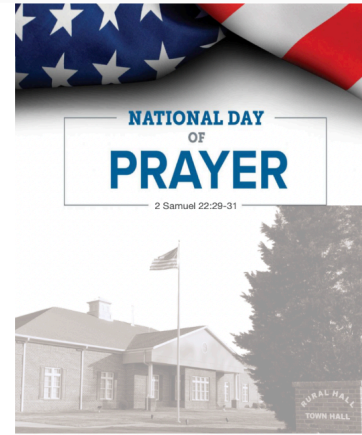
